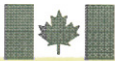

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Import Requirements

The import documentation must include:

- a) An Australian Export Certificate of Airworthiness to Canada signed by a representative of the Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA).

or

- b) A Certificate of Airworthiness for Export signed by the Airworthiness Authority of a country with whom Canada has a Bilateral Airworthiness agreement.

In case a) or b) the C of A must contain the following statement:

"The aircraft identified by this Certificate has been examined and found to conform to the Canadian Department of Transport Type Certificate A-213"

or

- c) Other procedures approved by the Minister of Transport

NOTE 1

The provisions for operating at maximum weights exceeding the certificated maximum weights, identified under "Data Pertinent to All Models, Operational Basis" in CASA TCDS No. VA519, are not applicable to aircraft registered in Canada. Aircraft registered in Canada may, through the granting of an exemption as addressed in Aircraft Certification Staff Instruction 26, be permitted to operate at gross weights exceeding the limits specified when engaged in special purpose agricultural operations for the aerial dispersal of jettisonable cargo.

NOTE 2

The reference to CAR 1988 under "Data Pertinent to All Models, Notes" in CASA TCDS No. VA519, is to an Australian regulation, not a Canadian Civil Aviation Regulation and is not applicable for Canadian registered aircraft.



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NOTE 3

The letters "GA" as written in the serial numbers eligible section of the CASA TCDS do not form part of the serial number.
